We are looking at a 4-day trip package, which has an estimated price of \$850.00. (This price may go up or down depending on the number of people we have going and fuel surcharges.)

Package includes:

- 3 nights lodging with security on duty for 7 hours
- 3 Continental breakfasts
- 2 dinners
- Admission to Skywalk Observatory, Tea Party Museum, Boston Duck Tour, and the Freedom Trail
- A Scholastica Travel Tour Leader on the motor coach
- Admission to the Boston Heritage Festival (Performance, Clinic, and Awards Ceremony)
- Insurance coverage on each participant (\$5000 emergency accident, \$1000 life, \$250 emergency dental)
- Roundtrip motor coach transportation

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YES, my child will be going on this trip. I understand my child may use his/her student account to help fund the trip and/or pay out of pocket. I understand any deposits, once sent to the travel agency, are only partially refundable depending upon the amount of notice I give. Students must ride on the charter bus going to the destination and during the trip. Students and chaperones must pay the full amount even if the students travel home a different way or stay longer (travel waiver required to be signed); otherwise, the price ends up having to be absorbed by the other participants. The AutoBell Fundraiser in November is a way to raise trip funds for your student.

STUDENTS WITHOUT HEALTH INSURANCE NEED TO HAVE THEIR PARENTS PURCHASE THE SCHOOL INSURANCE through Nationwide Life Insurance Company/K&K Insurance Group. Forms are available in the main office of Bailey and in the first-day packets.
